

Creation Station Steps

Welcome to Sunrise Greenhouse Creation Stations! The following steps will help you create a winter container and enjoy the process along the way. There are a few key points to keep in mind before you begin creating your winter container.

- Always trim the bottom of each piece of greenery before placing the branch in your pot.
- Keep all extra trimmings until your pot is complete.
- Turn your pot with every step, to ensure branches are facing outward.
- Keep taller branches towards the middle and shorter branches towards the edge of your pot.
- Ask if you have any questions. We are happy to help you along the way!
- Be creative! There is no right or wrong way to arrange your container. Make it how you like.

Phase 1: Establishing Structure

1. Fraser Fir

Cut the 3 branches of Fraser Fir to a uniform height. Trim off the small branches around the bottom of the trunk. Then place your 3 branches in the middle of the pot in a triangle, with the branches facing outward.

2. Princess Pine

Trim three Princess Pine branches off the main trunk and place them around the Fraser Fir.

3. Douglas Fir

Trim three branches of Douglas Fir and place them around the Fraser Fir.

4. Noble Fir

Trim three full branches off the main stem of your Noble Fir and place them around the container.

5. Port Orford Cedar

Trim three branches of Port Orford Cedar; place them wherever you like.

Phase 2 - Creativity

6. Fill In Empty Spaces

Anywhere you see dirt, fill in with leftover branches of fir and pine until it is full. Be creative! Use your favorite pieces and arrange them as you like.

7. Bow and Pinecone

Choose a bow from our bow table and place it wherever you like. Then take your pinecone and place it wherever you like.

8. Oregonia

Take the Oregonia and place it wherever you like.

9. Juniper

Trim the Blue Berry Juniper and place it wherever you like.

10. Incense Cedar

Trim the Incense Cedar and place near the edge of your container, allowing it to drape over the side.

11. Branches and Berries

Place your white painted Birch branches or Red Twig Dogwood branches (depending on what is in your bundle) towards the middle of your container; then place the red berries wherever you like.

12. Evaluate and Enjoy

Look over your container and adjust anything you want. Then bring it home and enjoy!

Note: Be sure to water your container in when you bring it home.
